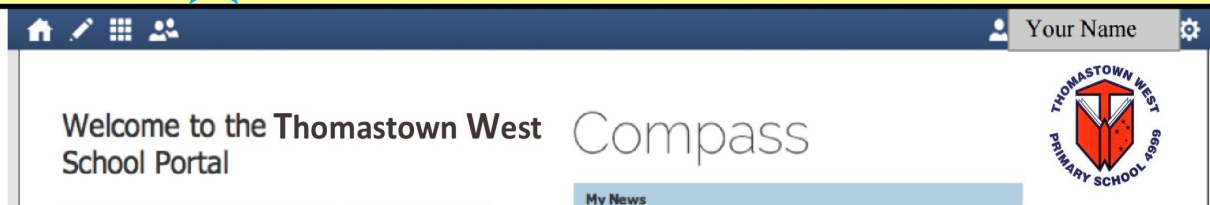

Click OK and wait for the report to appear. (This may take a minute or so.)

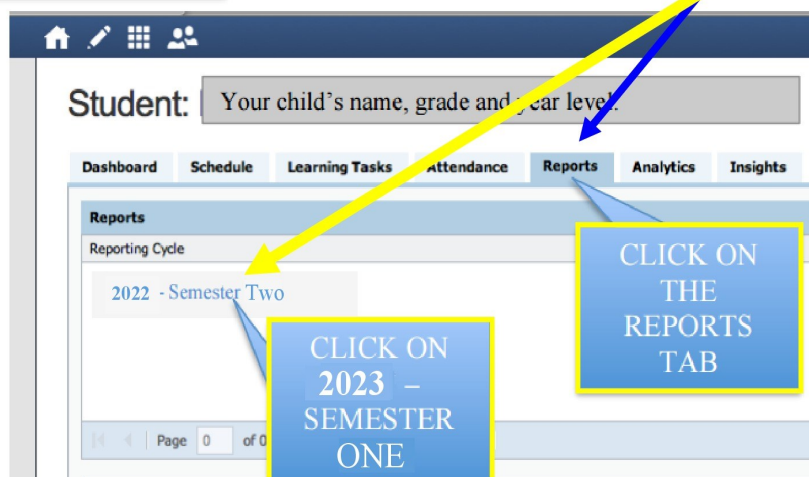
6. Click on 'Open' or 'Save'.

CHANGES TO CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

From 10th July 2023, there are changes to the way Child Care Subsidy (CCS) entitlements are calculated.

This means your family's CCS may increase

From the 10th of July 2023, the Australian Government will be increasing its CCS rates for families. This means that the maximum CCS rate will be increasing from 85% to 90% for families earning \$80,000 or less.

Please note, this table is a guide only and changes to centre fees, the law, policy or your individual circumstances may mean that any Child Care Subsidy you are entitled to may differ from the amount shown.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO

If you already get CCS, you don't need to do anything to get the increased rate. The changes will automatically apply for you from 10 July 2023.

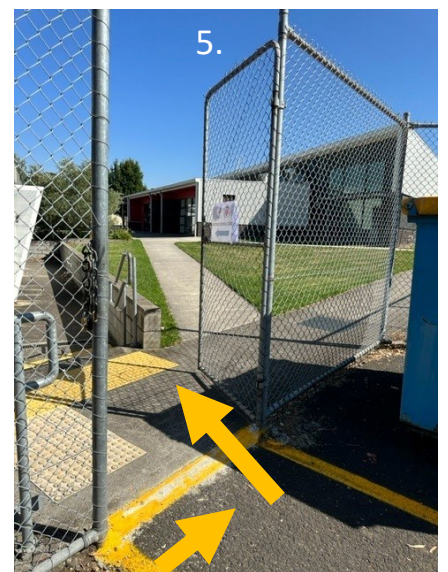

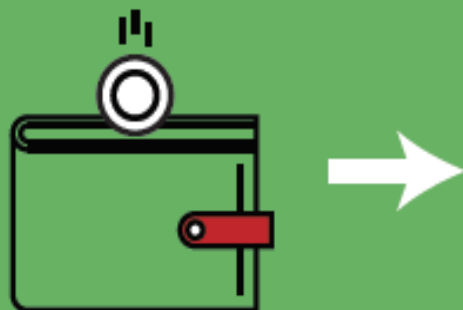


4. ORDER

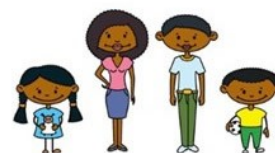
