What about Before School care?

From Term 4 2023, Thomastown West Primary School will return to our traditional TWPS Breakfast Club but with a few necessary changes!

- > Breakfast Club will open at 7:45am.
- > Breakfast Club is FREE.
- ➤ Breakfast Club will operate from our Thomastown West Community Hub.
- Students will enter Breakfast Club via the single Hub gate on Main Street.
- From 7:45am 8:15am parents or carers must drop their child at Breakfast Club and sign them in.
- From 8:15am students may arrive at Breakfast Club in the Hub and sign in without their parents or carers.
- > Students are encouraged to bring a small toy or game to play. There are plenty of books to read at the Hub.
- ➤ The Breakfast Club will close at 8:30am and the single Hub gate on Main Street will be closed.
- ➤ At 8:30am the double gates at the front entrance of our school will be opened for students to enter.



READ, GROW, INSPIRE

Each year since 1945, Book Week has brought children and books together across Australia During this time schools and public libraries spend one glorious week celebrating books and Australian children's authors and illustrators. The 2023 Book Week theme is "Read, Grow, Inspire" is focused on how literature has the capacity to develop a child's inner world and how it can plant the seed of inspiration for them to express their own creativity. Consider the metaphor: children are almost like plants and literature is the sun, the soil, and the water. With good literature, your children can grow and flourish. This not only celebrates the wonderful relationship between children and books but also honours the authors and the role they play in a child's development.

At Thomastown West, we celebrate Book Week and highlight the importance of reading. Anything that furthers children's ability to read and spark a love of reading that will stay with young people for life is an important cause! Today's parade with students dressed as their favourite book character was absolutely fabulous! Thank you to our Parents and

Carers for their time and effort understanding how important reading is for child's cognitive and emotional development), by supporting their child to acknowledge their favourite books and characters ,as well as celebrate how quality literature affects how your child reads, how it helps them grow, and how it can also inspires them!



Prep Circus is a wonderful day for students to collaborate with other Prep students as they participate in engaging circus related activities that also serve as a motivating writing prompt. I suspect our Prep parents will hear about the pop corn and fairy floss, not necessarily about the writing!

Authentic writing prompts play a vital role in fostering meaningful and creative writing. When prompts are authentic, they reflect real-world situations, emotions, and dilemmas that connect with our young writers. This not only engages the Preps on a personal level but also encourages them to draw from their own experiences, thoughts, and feelings.

Another Sun Smart Reminder

Excessive exposure to the sun's ultraviolet radiation can cause health problems including skin cancer. UV radiation cannot be seen or felt, can pass through light clouds and peaks during school hours. All children are expected to be in full school uniform every day, and from 1st September this includes student wearing their school hats. School hats are to be worn from September 1st until the end of April 2023. Please make sure that your child has a wide brim hat/bucket or legionnaire style hat with them at school. If your child lost their hat, they can be purchased at the office for \$14.

PLEASE NOTE: Sunscreen can be brought from home and applied by students. Sunscreen cannot be shared as allergies must be taken into consideration.

However, more time may be allocated to your conference if your child has their Student Support Group (SSG) meeting scheduled.

Understanding the signs around school zones



40km/h sign

All school speed limits across the State are clearly signposted. Look out for the speed signs near schools and slow down to improve safety for children.



No parking

It is important that you do not park in any area where this sign is displayed.



Children crossing

When the flags are displayed at a children's crossing, you must stop for pedestrians who are waiting to cross or who have started crossing. You must remain stopped until the crossing is clear. These rules apply even if there is no crossing supervisor.



No stopping

No stopping means you must not stop at the kerb for any reason.



Yellow edge lines

Must not stop or park your vehicle next to a continuous yellow edge line.



Understanding the rules at school crossings

- · Please keep the children's crossing clear.
- Parking is not allowed within 20m before a school crossing or 10m after the crossing (unless otherwise signposted). Parking within this area makes it difficult for children and the crossing supervisor to get a clear view of the road.
- It is illegal to double park your car, ie. you are not allowed to stop next to a parked car.

What you can do to ensure school zones remain safe

- Supervise children in or near traffic.
- Consider walking or cycling with your child to and from school.
- Respect the road rules and parking signs.
- Wait on the same side of the road as your child, to avoid your child dashing across the road to meet you.
- Get your child into the habit of using the car's kerbside doors, away from the traffic.

Here is some information regarding arrangements for our whole school Concert.

Students must be accompanied by an adult
