

When you use COMPASS to book a conference meeting with your teacher, it will be a time that you choose, which suits YOUR FAMILY! It is also really easy to let us know (on Compass) if you require an interpreter!

For parents and carers that do not have access to the internet at home, at work, Thomastown Library, or at a friend's house, support will be available at the office from 2:30pm Monday 28th August 2023 onwards, so that parents and carers can still make bookings online. <u>Each Parent/Student/Teacher Conference is strictly 15 minutes and spaces are limited</u>. However, more time may be allocated to your conference if your child has their Student Support Group (SSG) meeting scheduled.

Due to the casual teacher shortage, TWPS is finding it incredibly challenging to cover the Specialist Teachers for their individual planning day. As a result, Specialist Teachers will not attend Parent/Student/Teacher conference meetings this term. Instead, they will be participating in their own professional practice day planning for Term 4.

Here is some information regarding arrangements for Thursday evening's Concert Performance

- Students must be accompanied by an adult
- Students will need to arrive at <u>6.45 pm</u> to allow time for dressing, and to enable the concert to start promptly at <u>7.30pm</u>. Remember, it takes a good deal of time to dress small children. <u>There will be a "Sign In" and "Sign Out" folder so that teachers can ensure all students are accounted for.

- Students will go directly to their classrooms to meet their grade teachers.
- Parents will take their children to their classroom, then go directly to the TSC Gym to
 be seated for the performance. <u>Tickets are in the form of a wrist band which</u>
 should be worn for ease of identification. Seats are not numbered. Tickets
 should be shown at the door, and guests will be escorted to their seats by Staff.
 NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD ON THE NIGHT.
- Photos and videos are allowed to be taken. There will be no video for sale. However, please avoid blocking the view of the seated audience members, moving to stand in the front, or calling out during performances.


The Concert will be held in the Thomastown Secondary College ECCA (Gym) and will start at 7.30pm.
