However, it is important that parents focus not only on the wellbeing of their own child, but also upon the wellbeing of other children and the staff. If you need to administer Panadol/Nurofen before school, then your child should not be at school. If your child has vomited or had diarrhoea, they must be <u>completely well for 24 hours</u> before returning to school.

When you use COMPASS to book a conference meeting with your teacher, it will be a time that you choose, which suits YOUR FAMILY! It is also really easy to let us know (on Compass) if you require an interpreter!

For parents and carers that do not have access to the internet at home, at work, Thomastown Library, or at a friend's house, support will be available at the office from 2:30pm Monday 28th August 2023 onwards, so that parents and carers can still make bookings online. <a href="Each Parent/Student/Teacher Conference">Each Parent/Student/Teacher Conference</a> is strictly 15 minutes and spaces are limited. However, more time may be allocated to your conference if your child has their Student Support Group (SSG) meeting scheduled.

Due to the casual teacher shortage, TWPS is finding it incredibly challenging to cover the Specialist Teachers for their individual planning day. As a result, Specialist Teachers will not attend Parent/Student/Teacher conference meetings this term. Instead, they will be participating in their own professional practice day planning for Term 4.
